RESOLUTION OF THE PLAINFIELD MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF UNION FOR LEAF COMPOSTING SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority"), a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, was created by the Plainfield City Council pursuant to Ordinance MC-1995-19 and in accordance with the Municipal and County Utilities Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq., (the "MUA Law") and was given the responsibility to implement and operate a municipal utilities authority which will provide certain solid waste and sewerage services to the inhabitants of the City of Plainfield (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, the County of Union (the "County") offers leaf composting services at the County Conservation Center for Union County municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the County has offered such services to the City of Plainfield at a rate established at \$2.00 per yard for loose leaves and \$4.00 per yard for compacted leaves; and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in this program the County requires execution of a standard Hold Harmless Agreement by all participating municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to participate in the County program and recommends the Agreement with the County; and

WHEREAS, as set forth in the Certification of Funds from the Authority's Chief Financial Officer, adequate funds are available for this expenditure.

RESOLUTION OF THE PLAINFIELD MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE FOR MEDIUM AND LIGHT DUTY VEHICLES

WHEREAS, The Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority"), a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, was created by the Plainfield City Council pursuant to Ordinance MC-1995-19 and in accordance with the Municipal and County Utilities Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq., (the "MUA Law") and was given the responsibility to implement and operate a municipal utilities authority which will provide certain solid waste and sewerage services to the inhabitants of the City of Plainfield (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has solicited bids for the repair and maintenance of medium and light duty vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Authority received four (4) bids in response to the bid solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Varga Enterprises, Inc., was deemed to be the lowest responsible bid by the Authority's Qualified Purchasing Agent and the bid submitted by Doctor Diesel was deemed the second lowest responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Superintendent of Fleet Maintenance has recommended that a primary contract be awarded to Varga Enterprises, Inc. and a secondary contract to Doctor Diesel, each for a two year term. The combined contracts shall not exceed \$20,000 for year one and \$20,000 for year two; and

WHEREAS, as set forth in the Certification of Funds from the Authority's Chief Financial Officer, adequate funds are available for this purpose for Calendar Year 2010 and a Certification of Funds shall be provided for the second year of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Authority hereby authorizes the execution of a contract with Varga Enterprises, Inc. and with Doctor Diesel for the repair and maintenance of medium and light duty vehicles as set forth above. The contract with Varga shall be the primary contract, which shall be utilized first and the contract with Doctor Diesel shall be a secondary contract for use in the event Varga can not provide the services required.
